Today's Verse:

"Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven"

(Matthew 6:10, NIV).

God longs to give you a glimpse of heaven while you are here on earth. He wants to show you His wonderful plan and bring it to pass in your life. Have you ever thought about how God's will is accomplished in heaven? In heaven, God's will is automatic. There are no opposing forces of darkness or anything that can come against His will.
